



C7 – Role Description – Umpire Coordinator

General Purpose of Role

Key Specifics of Role

- Attend club committee meetings and provide input to relevant topics
- Assist the club committee in the appointment process of umpires
- Conduct club umpire meetings to cover areas of support and umpire development
- Ensure umpires have access to and complete required umpire accreditation
- Assist umpires with their re accreditation needs and processes
- Provide necessary up to date information and technical knowledge on current umpiring trends and rule changes
- Use expertise to work with external umpire groups
- Develop a positive club umpiring culture

Additional Responsibilities

- Support request to attend club meetings on behalf of the President
- Attend game days throughout the season to assist umpires as required
- Assist club President and committee as required
