



D4 – Role Description – Auskick Coordinator

Mundaring Junior Football Club (MJFC) is a community based club which promotes and encourages Australian Rules Football for girls and boys from Auskick up to year 6.

With the help from volunteers in official and non-official roles, we aim to provide a safe and fun environment for boys and girls to participate and learn the game of Australian Rules Football.

General Purpose of Role

The key purpose of this role is to provide support and development to players, concentrating on enjoyment and skill development to ensure continued interest and involvement in the game. This role requires emphasis on players having fun, promoting the healthy mental and physical development of players and encouraging good sportsmanship.

Key Specifics of Role

- Develop coach action plan specific to age group
- Plan relevant and age skill specific programs for match and training situations
- Understand rules of the game and communicate to players
- Facilitate setting up and packing up of ground on home game day
- Nominate assistant coaches, and mentor as required
- Communicate with players and parents age group game rules, training and match day procedures, and player responsibilities
- Ensure equal game time and rotation of player positions on game day throughout season
- Use expertise to work with groups of players across age group and utilise outside resources if required
- Promote a positive club culture for parents, players and officials
- Liaise with Team Manager to ensure communication of game day duties for parents and volunteers

Additional Responsibilities and personal training requirements

- Complete AFL level 1 coach accreditation
- Assist Coaching Coordinator as required
- Support request to attend club meetings on behalf of the Coaching Coordinator
- Sign and abide by coaches code of conduct
